There is a groundswell of momentum and a growing movement of solidarity against systemic and historic racism towards the Black community.


We believe in bringing people of diverse backgrounds, experiences, and points of view to ignite innovation in design.

How To APPLY

Our scholarships aim to break down the barriers for students to access architecture + design school. The microscholarships are intended for studio materials, books, etc.

Black students enrolled at a U.S. notfor-profit educational institution who will begin their final year of a NAABaccredited architecture program in the Fall of 2021 are eligible to apply*.

AWARDS

(5) \$10,000 Tuition Scholarships

APPLY ONLINE

Applicants for the scholarship must complete the following no later than 11:59 PM EST on January 15, 2021.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Complete an online application which includes:

- Resume
- A Letter of Recommendation from the dean or chair of the program. The letter must confirm that the applicant meets the eligibility criteria and describe their professional excellence.
- Design Challenge Sketch and explanation.
- One advanced-level architecture project with written description (500 words and 10 pages, maximum). Work done with a single partner may be submitted, but it must include a description of the applicant's specific contribution and a letter of support from the applicant's collaborative partner.
- Finalists will be invited to submit a digital video that introduces themselves to the jury and presents their work.

MICRO-SCHOLARSHIPS

ELIGIBILITY

Black students enrolled at a U.S. not-for-profit educational institution who will be in an architecture program in the Fall of 2021 are eligible to apply*.

AWARDS

(10) Micro-scholarships of various amounts ranging from \$1,000-\$2,500

APPLY ONLINE

Applicants for the scholarship must complete the following no later than 11:59 PM EST on January 15, 2021.

*Current employees, recent former employees, and interns of Gensler, as well as their immediate families and those Gensler deems to present conflicts of interest, are ineligible to participate.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Complete an online application which includes:

- Resume
- A Letter of Recommendation from a dean, chair, or faculty member in the program. The letter must confirm that the applicant meets the eligibility criteria and describe their professional excellence.
- Essay Question, 500 words max




